## Soap Sculpture Contest Supports Water For People

Entries can be as simple as a classic soap bar carving to an elaborate multi-media creation using soap, or a mix of soap-related and other found or created objects. Follow these simple rules:

1. Sculptures should be at least 50% soap, in any form, shape, or color.
2. Keep shipping weight under 70 pounds; total length plus girth dimension under 130 inches. Parts may be disassembled for shipping.
3. Entry fee is \$50.00.

Take the challenge and maybe your sculpture will win an award for Best Interpretation of Theme, E for Effort, or Crude but Effective. Come prepared to bid like a pro, and don't miss the chance to fund raise in advance. It's for a great cause.
